Program Options:

Center Based: Early Head Start center based offers a caring, nurturing environment for infants and toddlers while parents are working, attending school or completing job training. The center is open Monday through Friday from 6:45 am-5:00pm, year round.

Home Based: Early Head Start home based supports infant and toddler development through weekly home visits with the child and parent designed to meet the individual needs of each child. Twice monthly socializations offer an opportunity for families and children to build relationships and share information and experiences.

Staff:

The staff of the Manchester Early Head Start programs have over 40 years combined experience working with infants and toddlers. They have degrees in Early Childhood Education, with specialized training and coursework in infant and toddler development and care.
